PRINTING A BORDER AROUND AN IMAGE USING LIGHTROOM FOR PROJECTED IMAGE (OR TO SEND OFF FOR PRINTING OR PRINT YOURSELF)

Go to PRINT Module

Step 1

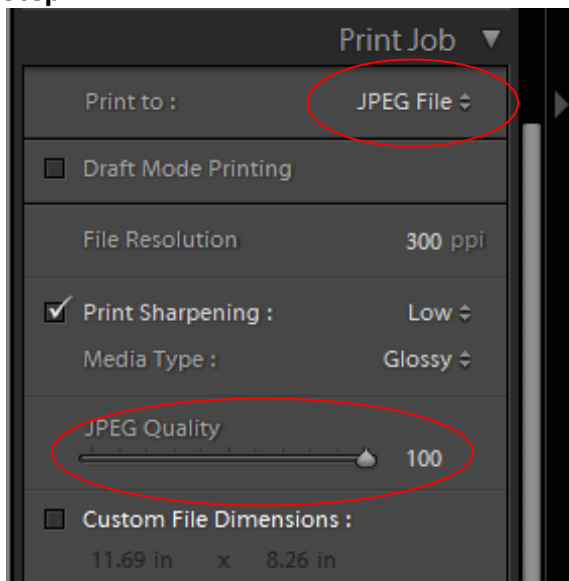


In Image Settings, tick box marked Stroke Border

Set Stroke Border width as required (Normally for a Projected Image, 1 or 2 pixels is sufficient)

Click Colour Box to select Colour of Stroke Border

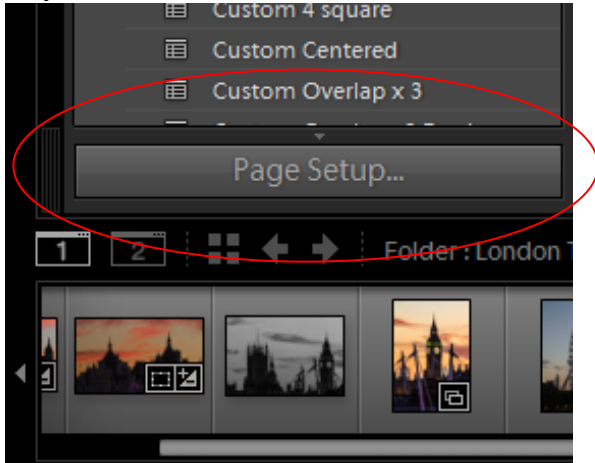
Step 2



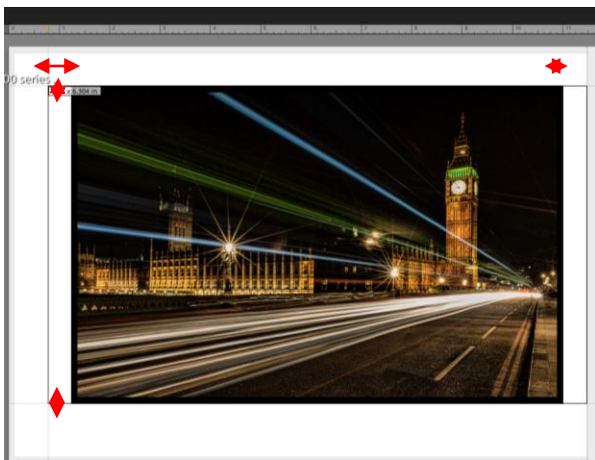
If its a jpg for Projected Image, proceed to Step 5

If you are intending to Print the image, in Print Job, select "jpg" not printer

Step 3



If its a print you are printing yourself, Go to Page Setup and set Paper Size using Printer Dialogue box.

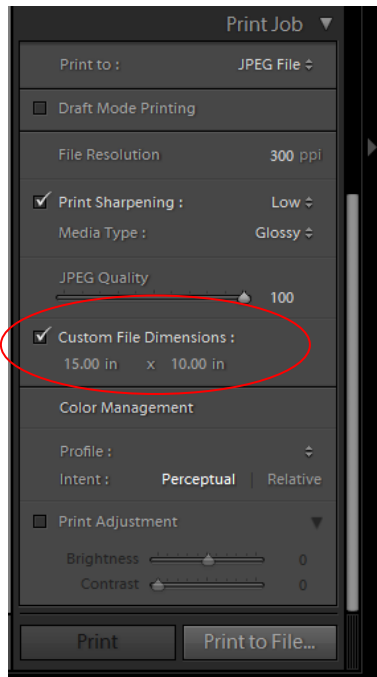


Adjust where you want the margins to be on your print by dragging the image borders

Then Print

If its a print you are going to send off for printing, got to Step 4

Step 4

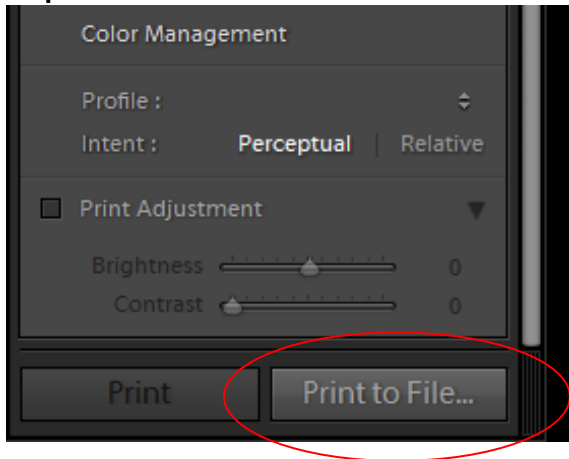


If you are sending off the print for printing say to DS Colour, you will need to choose the paper size you will be using at DS Colour

Go to Print Job, Tick Custom Size and then enter your desired paper size, say 15 inches * 10 inches

Then adjust the white border as required as per Step 3

Step 5



To save image as a JPG "Print to File" with jpeg quality set to 100

If the image is for a Projected Image competition, you will need to re-import into Lightroom so that you can size it to 1400 * 1050 pixels (see Guidance for Projected Images)
